People have talked about this happening for more than 2000 years. That just means it is 2000 years closer to happen than ever before.

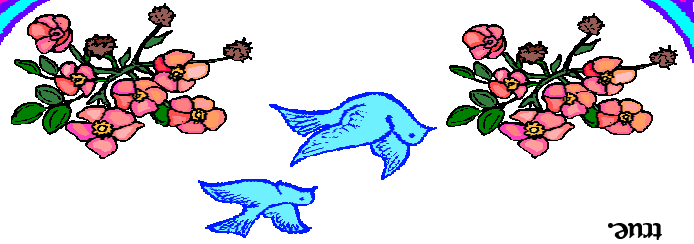
Jesus will come in someone's life time!
