I will hold you with the right hand of my righteousness.

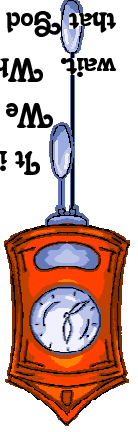
It may be that it is just not God's time for that thing to happen. God has a plan for our lives. He has a way in which he will work it out, and he has a time in which it will happen.
