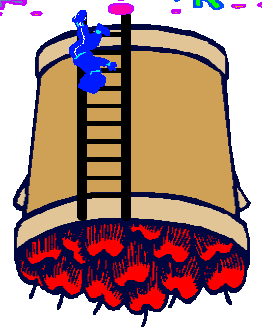
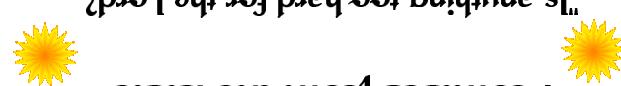


Nothing is too hard for God.
