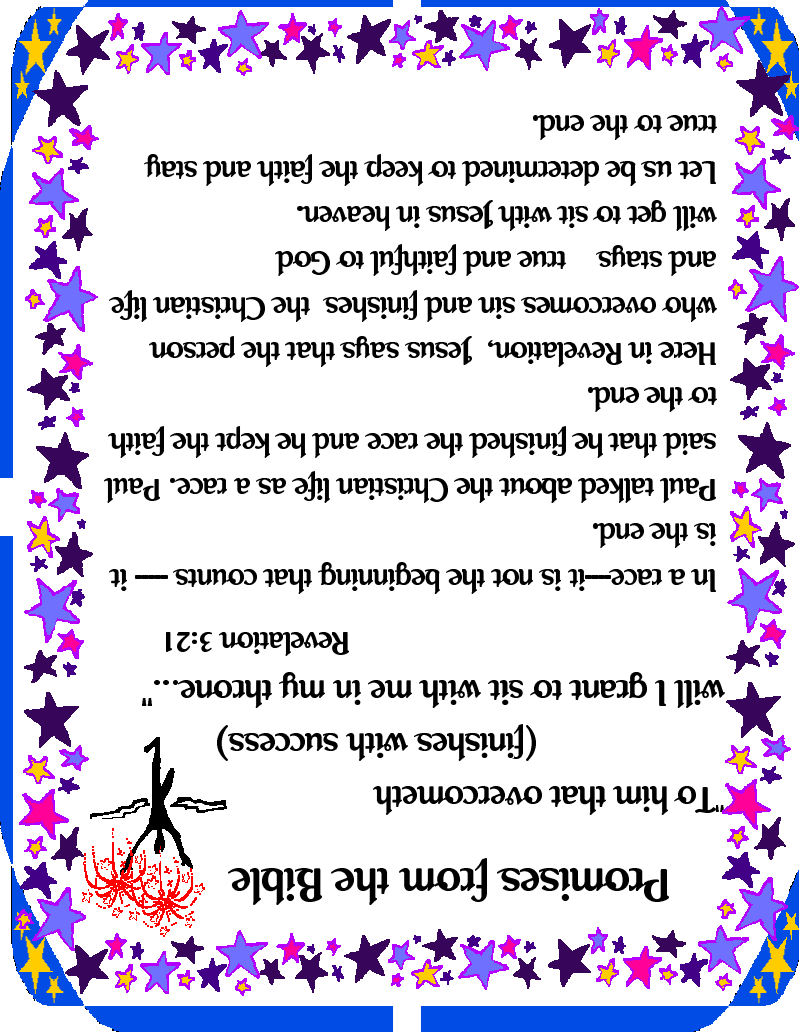




How different our life would be if we really did this every day!

"What time I am afraid, I will trust in You." Psalm 56:3



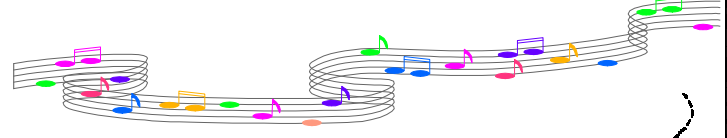
King Saul was trying to find David to kill him. David went to a neighboring country. He thought that he would be safe there. But some of the
